Suicide prevention book sets target: Cut mortality by 10%

Cases on the rise across the country, especially post Covid-19; Mental health to be part of curriculum in schools, colleges

THE Ministry for Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) recently released the first-ever National Suicide Prevention Strategy book, which aims to reduce suicide mortality by 10 per cent in the country by 2030.

The report stated that there is a need to establish effective surveillance mechanisms for suicides within three years, to establish psychiatry OPD that

provide suicide prevention services in all districts within five years, and to integrate mental well-being curriculum in all educational institutions within the next eight years.

Experts and medical professionals state that while other countries regularly have such reports, it is the first time it has been recorded in India. This is because the number of cases is on the rise, more so since Covid-19.

A senior MoHFW official said that cases of suicide are higher among men, as compared to women, in 2020, but now cases among women and children are also on the rise.

There is, thus, a need to have special spaces in offices, educational institutions, residential associations and other areas where people can reach out easily and talk to seek help. There should be regular sessions with

dialogues and conversations in educational institutions and work spaces to understand what a person is going through. Experts should be roped in to assess feedback and observe people to spot early signs and give immediate help.

Dr Pratima Murthy, director and senior professor of psychiatry, National Institute of Mental Health and Neuro Sciences (Nimhans),

said while psychosocial factors have led to a rise in cases, there has also been an increase after Covid-19. Thus, there is a need for a multi-sectoral approach to address the issue. There is a need for all sorts of engagement to reduce cases, and also reduce easy availability and public access to organophosphorous compounds like acid and pesticide.

Admitting that most youth today are suffering from anxiety, depression and

other issues, Dr Murthy said that responsible medical prescription and treatment plays a crucial role.

The report includes World Health Organisation's approach in suicide prevention, known as 'LIVE LIFE' — Leadership, Interventions, Vision and Evaluation (LIVE) and Less means for suicide, Interaction with media, Form the young, Early identification (LIFE) as a cross-cutting strategy.

5.86 lakh disabled get UDID cards

HEALTH Minister Dr K Sudhakar on Tuesday said that around 5.86 lakh Unique Disability Identification Cards (UDID) have been distributed to needy citizens so far. The maximum number has been issued in Ramanagara, Chikkamagaluru and Bagalkot districts.

Distribution was also recorded in Haveri, Uttara Kananda, Belagavi and Mandya. He said the purpose of the cards is to help the disabled avail of several government benefits. The cards are being distributed in collaboration with the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities.

Citizens must register their names on the UDID portal to get the card and avail the facilities. "With the UDID cards, the government can track beneficiary facilities at all levels of implementation — block, district, state and national. Earlier, only seven types of impairments were considered in the disability list. But after the amendment of the RPWD Act of 2016, an additional 21 types of disabilities have been included.

Political party worker ends life, blames 4

A 32-year-old worker of a political party ended his life by jumping into a lake in Doddabalapura on Monday evening.

The deceased, Vinod Kumar, a resident of Kacheripalya, left behind a suicide note naming four persons, including a woman, for trying to stymie his growth in politics. Kumar was active in politics for several years and is said to have a huge following as he was active in social service. The police said based on a complaint by Kumar's family, a case of abatement to suicide has been registered against councillor Manjunath; Narayanappa, Dharmesh, and the wife of a contractor. Probe revealed that Kumar used to work with the Congress and had recently moved to the BJP. Following this, Manjunath started harassing him, asking him not to stay with the BJP, police said.

The body was fished out on Tuesday morning. Kumar's family protested demanding the immediate arrest of those responsible for his death.

Buying diapers proves costly for new father

A 30-year-old man who was trying to buy diapers online for his newborn baby, lost his hard-earned money after he was tricked by cyber fraudsters. The accused called the victim under the pretext of confirming the order and gave his contact info to fill in some details, including the address where the order was to be placed.

Unaware of the plot, the victim clicked on the link, giving access to his mobile, and the accused transferred funds

from his UPI account to his own. The victim lost nearly Rs 50,000. CEN police registered a case. The victim was identified as BT Santosh Kumar, a resident of Bengaluru-Ramanagar Road. The victim, a driver, filed a complaint on Saturday.

"The details of the mobile phone through which the accused contacted the victim is being checked. The victim lost the money in multiple transactions. He should have informed the bank asking for stop payment, but he did not act," said the police.

2 conmen held, garments worth ₹30L seized

BENGALURU: Two interstate conmen who were targeting wholesale garment dealers by purchasing clothes in bulk and giving postdated cheques, were arrested by Jayanagar police. The cheques would bounce due to insufficient funds or mismatch in signatures. A dealer in Jayanagar filed a complaint last year and the accused duo was arrested last week. There are similar complaints against the accused in Delhi, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and various police stations in Bengaluru. The arrested are identified as Param Singh and Vimal, both natives of Tamil Nadu. Police recovered readymade garments worth around Rs 30 lakh from the duo. **ENS**

BMTC bus claims life of 16-year-old girl

A 16-year-old girl died while her sibling and mother escaped with injuries after a speeding BMTC bus rammed into their scooter on Old Madras Road in KR Puram on Tuesday. The deceased, Layashree V, was a Class 9 student at a private school in TC Palya. The police said the inci-

dent occurred at 7.30 am when Priyadarshini (45) was taking her two children — Layashree and Yashwin (11) — to school on a scooter.

On Old Madras Road, she took a right turn to reach Bhattarahalli from the service road when a BMTC bus rammed into the scooter from the rear. While Priyadarshini and Yashwin fell to their left,

Layashree fell to the right and sustained severe injuries. She was rushed to a hospital where she was declared brought dead. "We have seized the bus and arrested driver Mahendra," the KR Puram traffic police said.

On October 22, 22-year-old MSc student Shilpa Shree was mowed down by a BMTC bus on the Jnanabharati campus.
